How to Read the Data:

Grey Block example:

In the Fall 2004 Cohort of 1,782 students, 997 were female
Of the 997 females in the Sub-Cohort, 224 (22.5%) graduated
Of the 1,782 in the Cohort, 224 females (13.1%) graduated

Green Block example:

Of the 997 females, 279 (28.0%) received both Pell & Stanford
Of the 279 females who received both Pell & Stanford, 34 (12.2%) graduated
Of the Fall Cohort of 1,782 students, 34 (1.9%) females who received both Pell & Stanford graduated
