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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The number of enrolled 2008-2009 ACT-tested freshmen (964) represents (21%) of student score reports received by your campus. Enrolled counts shown in this report are limited to those students your institution identified as enrolled full-time and degree seeking. It is assumed that enrolled students for whom a full-time/degree seeking status was not provided are full-time/degree seeking.

The average ACT composite score for your ACT-tested enrolled freshmen was 21.8 (men = 22.2, women = 21.3). The national ACT composite for 2007-2008 high school graduates was 21.1.
