EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The number of enrolled 2010-2011 ACT-tested freshmen (697) represents (16%) of student score reports received by your campus. Enrolled counts shown in this report are limited to those students your institution identified as enrolled full-time and degree seeking. It is assumed that enrolled students for whom a full-time/degree seeking status was not provided are full-time/degree seeking.

The average ACT composite score for your ACT-tested enrolled freshmen was 21.9 (men = 21.9, women = 21.9). The national ACT composite for 2009-2010 high school graduates was 21.0.
